Vice President's Message

As your SHHA Vice President, I recently represented SHHA at the Bernalillo County District 4 Coalition meeting. The January 6th meeting was the perfect opportunity for District 4 Neighborhood Association Leaders to meet their District Representatives, and conversely, for the Legislators to get to know Neighborhood Leaders and learn from them how they can help to make their communities better. Again the purpose of this meeting is to get more acquainted with all of our neighborhoods within District 4 and for the residential leadership to hear and become aware about the various issues and concerns facing our respective communities. Feedback was given to the Bernalillo County leadership that their website is not very comprehensive with information nor very user friendly. We then learned that they are currently working to change both content and ease of use and were aware of the shortfalls.

A major theme that surfaced at this meeting was the Railrunner train and all the issues this new transit service is causing. Concerns surfaced about traffic in loading and unloading areas, security at the loading stations at night, and the unreasonable number of times the train blows its horn daily. Since many of the New Mexico House and Senate Legislators were in attendance too and were offered a few minutes to speak, budget concerns and Tax Lightning surfaced. Both topics will be ongoing issues as we enter the new year.

County Commissioner Michael Weiner did report that the widening of Eubank to Paseo is on schedule and will be an eleven (11) month project beginning March of this year. A public hearing will be held soon for the North Abq Acres residents to address their concerns during this construction.

On another topic, as your current SHHA Vice President, I am beginning our search for new officers interested in serving on the SHHA Board for next year (2010-2011). We currently have a great team and I know we will need additional volunteers and Board Members as we begin our new year that starts at our annual meeting in June. MAIL THEFT

Mail theft is still a problem! We advise that you take your outgoing mail to the Post Office. If the option is available it



might be best to have sensitive information like checks, insurance and mortgage papers sent to your bank branch and you can pick them up from there, rather than having them sent to your house. Likewise, consider opening a post office box and have your mail sent there. Otherwise, keep your eye out for the postman and get your mail out of your box quickly. The closest collection box is at the Circle K office. Pick-up time is 4pm Mon-Sat.

Radon is an invisible, odorless gas known to cause cancer. Everyone is exposed to Radon at some level. Millions of homes and buildings contain high levels of Radon gas. The EPA and the Office of the Surgeon General recommend that all homes below the third floor be tested for Radon. Because Radon is invisible and odorless, a simple test is the only way to determine if a home has high Radon levels.

New Mexico Environment Department

- The New Mexico Environment Department, in conjunction with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, have designated January 2009 as Radon Action Month.
- Starting in January, NMED will have free radon test kits available for NM residents willing to share their test results as part of a statewide radon survey.
- To participate, please call 1-800-324-5928 to request form.

Health Effects From Radon Exposure

- No immediate symptoms.
- Estimated to contribute to between 7,000 and 30,000 lung cancer deaths each year.
- Smokers are at higher risk of developing Radon-induced lung cancer.

Steps to Reduce Exposure to Radon

- Take action if your Radon level is 4 picocuries per liter (pCi/L) or higher.
- Radon levels of less than 4 pCi/L still pose a risk, and in many cases, may be reduced.

How to Get a Radon Test Kit

• Test your home for Radon - it is easy and inexpensive. Requests for Radon Test kits can be sent to the National Safety Council's 1-800-SOS-RADON number (\$9.95) or Lowes Home Improvement Centers (\$16.88) per the NM Environment Department.
